


TRAJANO ROMAN BRIDGE



A Roman building located in the historic center of the city.

CHAVES CASTLE KEEP

National monument that houses the Chaves Military Museum.



CHAVES PILLORY



Located in Santa Maria Maior, it has been classified as a Property of Public Interest.

FLAVIENSE REGION MUSEUM

SANTA MARIA MAIOR CHURCH MATRIX CHURCH



It has a permanent collection of pieces on display dating from the 3rd century BC to pieces from the period of Romanization.



A space that combines history, art, spirituality and culture.



S. FRANCISCO FORT



The combination of well-preserved architecture and the transformation of part of the fort into a hotel makes this place unique. You can also enjoy panoramic views over the city and the Tâmega river valley.

MONFORTE OF RIO LIVRE CASTLE



POLDRAS



Preserved for centuries, the Poldras de Chaves are still a must-see and one of the wonders of the city.

This museum is an architectural work by Álvaro Siza Vieira dedicated to the life and work of the Portuguese painter and architect Nadir Afonso. It offers a unique opportunity to explore the talent and artistic vision of this illustrious son of Chaves.

ROMAN THERMAL MUSEUM



It offers the opportunity to explore the ruins of ancient Roman baths, which bear witness to the historical and cultural importance of the region.

WINE HOUSE



An interactive museum in Valpaços, where you can witness the culture of vines and wine, as well as its historical importance, is of exceptional social, cultural and economic importance, due to the variety and relevance of the activities linked to it.

It is an impressive testimony of Portugal's medieval history and architecture. With its grandeur and beauty, it offers a fascinating insight into the country's glorious past and its rich cultural heritage.

SANTA MARIA DAS JÚNIAS MONASTERY



It plays an important role in preserving the identity and traditions of the Montalegre region. Every year, on 15 August, there is a pilgrimage attended by the inhabitants of Pitões das Júnias and neighbouring towns.

In Vila Pouca de Aguiar, it represents one of the most important gold explorations of the Roman Empire. It has been classified as a Property of Public Interest and, more recently, as a Monument of Public Interest. The signposted trails make it possible to take an interpretedtour of this Roman public mine, from the global perspective from the viewpoints over the cortas to the incursion into the underground galleries, in the company of a guide.



CHAVES CASINO



Known for its cosy atmosphere and charming architecture that reflects the history and tradition of the region, the Casino offers a variety of machine and table games and a sophisticated restaurant. It is also a space where social and cultural events are organised.

TRESMINAS ROMAN MINING COMPLEX



CHAVES THERMAL BATHS



They are a renowned spa destination, offering relaxation and a cultural experience. They are popular for health treatments, relaxation or simply to explore the region's thermal tradition.

A pleasant spot with an unobstructed view, from where you can see the whole city and its vein.

A magnificent 100-hectare Centenary Park, which resembles an enchanted forest with its century-old trees: plane trees, magnolias, chestnut trees and camellias, the lake with its romantic island and thermal water springs.



Here you can enjoy nature in all

the various species of flora and fauna in a natural environment.

It is one of the most visited places in the county and ideal for family programmes. It combines biodiversity and nature with knowledge and leisure, presenting itself as an important centre for promoting conservation and preservation of the environment.

A pedestrianised circuit through nature, where you'll find small waterfalls, windmills, houses that look haunted, a medieval bridge and a Roman bridge.

BOTICAS PARK





BARROSO MOUNTAINS



At an altitude of 1279 metres, it is the eighth highest elevation in mainland Portugal.

> It is a park for recreational and sporting activities. It is currently considered to be one of the main tourist attractions in the northern Portugal.

BUCHEIRO ENVIRONMENTAL PARK (**RIBEIRA DE PENA**)



PENA AVENTURA PARK





It occupies an area of 18 hectares of protected forest, of great environmental value and with a rich biodiversity in terms of fauna and flora.

PEDRAS SALGADAS THERMAL PARK

It is one of the most beautiful parks in the interior of Portugal. With its 20 hectares of characteristic flora and fauna, it enjoys a favourable microclimate that enhances the splendour of nature. With a large lake, swimming poolsand marked hiking trails, the park invites you to go for a walk or cycle with family or friends. This is where the award-winning Agua das Pedras originates, which can be tasted here, 'in natura', exactly as it springs from the spring.

SANTIAGO ROUTE



One of the oldest and best-documented pilgrimage routes to Santiago de Compostela in Portugal is the Portuguese Interior Route to Santiago, which stretches from Viseu to Chaves and ends at Verin in the well-known Via da Prata.

It covers 2 hectares and has trees of great natural and ornamental relevance. Equipped with a picnic area, sports rink, trails and outdoor fitness equipment, it is the idyllic spot for a family picnic, with various entertainment options.

CHAVES FLAVOURS FAIR



This annual fair takes place on the first weekend of February. Here, the flavours of the region are celebrated and promoted by the various producers present: smoked meats, pastéis de Chaves, folar de Chaves and their wines. Visitors can also enjoy handicrafts and performances by local groups.

Every Friday the 13th you can experience the superstition and excitement of this date in Montalegre, with special events in bars and restaurants.



PEOPLE'S FESTIVAL

It takes place every year on the third weekend of August. A wide variety of socio-cultural activities take place over three days.

It takes place in August and local products can be found there. It came about as a way of promoting and revitalising an old activity with great traditions and to showcase local craft products and the tourist and gastronomic potential of the county.
